

NEHSA Financial Assistance Application



The New England Healing Sports Association (NEHSA) Scholarship Program is designed to financially assist qualified applicants who otherwise would not be able to participate in adaptive sports programs. From beginner to elite, NEHSA aims to support those individuals to achieve their athletic and recreational goals.

NEHSA has limited funding available to help qualified applicants who wish to experience our program. All scholarship recipients are asked to pay a minimum financial contribution for all lessons if possible and have a fully paid yearly membership fee, individual membership \$45.00, family membership \$70.00

Applicants will be considered on a first come, first served basis. Applications must be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to the first scheduled lesson. The total amount of the scholarship awarded is limited to the amount of money available in the fund for each fiscal year. Applicants will be awarded no more than six half day sessions.

The NEHSA Scholarship Committee will review each application. The Scholarship Committee is an impartial panel comprised of NEHSA Staff. The Committee will review completed applications and other submitted materials. All decisions of the Committee are final.

Scholarship applicants will be notified by phone or email outlining the scholarship amount and usage requirements.

Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, religion, sex, national origin, age, weight, or state of disability. All information provided will be kept confidential and is only viewed by the NEHSA Scholarship Committee. Statistical information from scholarship awards may be used for fundraising and grant reporting purposes.
